# CONDITIONS

**(No private cameras or video cameras permitted)**

- The submitted works must be the original work of the artist/photographer and not previously exhibited in the Hastings in the last 2 years. Only the originating artist/photographer may submit works. It is their sole responsibility to ensure that works submitted do not infringe any relevant copyright laws.
- Entry fees per work in Section 1 = \$30, Section 2 = \$250, Section 3 to 10 and 14 = \$15, Section 11 and 12 = \$5, Section 13 = \$8. Art Society members \$6 for section 13. Late entries not accepted.**
- All entries must be for sale, suitably framed and ready for hanging, including photographs.
- All works to be securely packed with suitable packing for return consignment. **NO GLASS to be sent through Australia Post. MAXIMUM dimensions for Australia Post parcels is 140cm girth x 105cm length with max. weight of 20kg. Australia Post in Port Macquarie will not accept items exceeding these dimensions. If refused by Australia Post, it will be the responsibility of the artist to arrange return of their unsold works.**

## CONDITIONS continued ...

- Each work to be clearly marked with artist's name, address, title, section and price, on the reverse side of the painting/photograph.
- The Port Macquarie Art Society shall retain 25% commission on sale of all works. Port Macquarie Art Society is not registered for GST.
- Every care shall be exercised but the organisers shall be in no way responsible for any damage, loss or theft.**
- All entries shall be judged but the Port Macquarie Art Society reserves the right to withhold any work considered unsuitable for hanging.
- The decision of the judge shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into. *Merit awards will be given.*
- The organisers reserve the right to have any work reproduced in the press, on television or the society's website for promotional purposes. Further, the organisers reserve the right to have the winning entry in any section reproduced in full colour, as a magazine illustration. Copyright claims, for these purposes only, will be deemed to be waived by the artist/photographer when work is submitted.

- All works not personally collected shall be returned as per instructions, or by the most practical means available – freight collect.
- The organisers reserve the right to withhold the awarding of a prize in any one section where, in the opinion of the judge, no work of a suitable standard has been submitted.
- The size of all art works submitted for hanging shall not exceed 12 square feet (1.1m<sup>2</sup>) excluding frame.
- An acquisitive prize, where applicable, will constitute the full purchase of the winning entry which will then become the property of the specific prize donor.**
- 'The Spirit of the Hastings' entrants must be residents of the Port Macquarie-Hastings municipality and their subject must also be from within the same area. Digital manipulation of the image is acceptable providing that the artwork is still recognisable as having originated from a photograph or photographs. Images will be judged by an accredited photography judge on artistic expression and impact, originality and technical quality. The sum of the four sides of mounted work not to exceed 210cm and thickness not to exceed 4cm. A spot or label must be placed at the top left corner of the back of the print so that curator can hang the work the right way. All work must be entered ready for hanging with a wire or cord hanger or a generous sized metal 'D' loop. If the photograph is framed under glass, non-reflective glass is not recommended as it will lower the image contrast and vibrancy and may disadvantage the work during judging.
- The following types of Art work cannot be accepted: batik, poker work, bark compositions. Plastic relief work. Unprotected tempera paintings, wet paintings, china painting, wood painting, tapestry or similar art forms due to lack of space.
- Panthers will not accept any works for this exhibition before due date Sunday, 1st April, 3-6pm and Monday, 2nd April 9-11am.**

## 37th ANNUAL EASTER ART EXHIBITION

The Port Macquarie News has enjoyed a long association with Port Macquarie and district. In its 130 years of service to the Hastings it has involved itself, through various means, in providing support to community events, organisations and individuals. The News is proud of its record in community support and maintains a strong commitment to the town and district.

Support in this year's Port Macquarie Art Society Easter Art Exhibition is another sign of the News at work in the community. Port Macquarie boasts an active involvement in the arts, and this exhibition in particular, has a record of attracting work by leading artists not only in Port Macquarie and district but far beyond.

### This Year's Judge: GORDON ROSSITER

Gordon Rossiter is a multi-award winning artist who has been painting professionally for over twenty years. In that time he has mounted over twenty solo exhibitions and won numerous awards in Australian art competitions, including the Macquarie 2000 Award in 1998, the Inaugural Adelaide Swift Award in 2003, the Hastings Heritage Award in 2003, Port Macquarie Easter Art Exhibition Open Prize Winner in 2005 and the Adelaide Swift Award a second time in 2006 and again in 2010.

Gordon is an accomplished art tutor and judge, who first began painting as a teenager while recuperating from a serious rodeo accident. He has been working at capturing landscapes in oils ever since.

Much of his painting is done on-site and shown in one-man exhibitions at the Bathers' Pavilion Gallery, Balmoral, Sydney and at the Gladstone Gallery near his home at Crescent Head, on the New South Wales North Coast where he lives with his wife and three children. He also has a permanent rotating exhibition at Sails Resort in Port Macquarie.

Gordon's work is predominately impressionistic, but with a strong representational feel to it. It is a unique style which successfully conveys the energy and moods of nature, rather than simply reproducing a faithful representation of a scene.
